ORIGINS: France, new variety (1968), obtained re-crossing a variety obtained crossing (Cinsaut X Perle de Csaba) X Cardinal.

PHENOLOGY:

BUNCHES: Medium-big, flexible, loosely packed, of good firmness. **AVERAGE WEIGHT:** 360-500 gr.

BERRIES: Medium-big, egg-shaped, goldening well under the sun; slightly thick skin; firm and juicy pulp, with small pips; neutral taste; average weight: 5 gr.

PRODUCTIVITY AND TRAILING SYSTEM: Cultivated in simple Guyot cut or in Royat string, both in long or short cut.

AVERAGE TECHNOLOGICAL POTENTIAL:
