ORIGINS: France, new variety (1974), obtained crossing Lival X Cardinal.

PHENOLOGY:

BUNCHES: Medium-big, cylindrical, loosely packed. **AVERAGE WEIGHT:** 450-500 gr.

BERRIES: Medium-big; crisp skin; firm and juicy pulp, with small pips; slightly aromatic taste; average weight: 5 gr.

PRODUCTIVITY AND TRAILING SYSTEM: Cultivated in pergola or in trellis. Of regular production.
