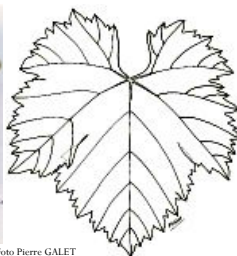

ORIGINS: Oriental, a very ancient and spread variety.

PHENOLOGY:

Budding	Flowering	Ripening
3 rd decade of April	1 st decade of June	2 ^o decade of September

BUNCHES: Big, tree-shaped, long, with grapes well pulled apart. **AVERAGE WEIGHT:** 700 gr.

BERRIES: Big, egg-shaped; thick skin; sweet pulp, with pips; of neutral taste; average weight: 9 gr.

PRODUCTIVITY AND TRAILING SYSTEM: Vigorous, requires high cultivation forms and long cut. Fertility: 1.2. Produces up to 30 tons / ha. Favours rootstocks as 1103P and 140Ru.

SENSITIVITY TO ADVERSITIES: Very sensitive to downy mildew and exco-riosis (dead arm). Sensitive also to grey mold.

GLOBAL EVALUATION: Good resistance to transport and storage. Taste widely well accepted by consumers.
