**ORIGINS:** Romania ( Dragasani Institut of Viticulture Research), obtained crossing Cardinal X Dattier de Beyrouth (Afuz Ali).

### PHENOLOGY:

**BUNCHES:** Big, packed, tree-shaped. **AVERAGE WEIGHT:** 600-700 gr.

**BERRIES:** Big, long egg-shaped, yellow-greenish coloured; crisp pulp, with pips; neutral taste; average weight: 12 gr.

**PRODUCTIVITY AND TRAILING SYSTEM:** Easily adaptable to long as well as short cuts, cultivated in trellis. Productivity: 20-25 ton / ha. Favours vigorous rootstocks as: 1103P, 140Ru and SO4.

### AVERAGE TECHNOLOGICAL POTENTIAL:

**SENSITIVITY TO ADVERSITIES:** Sensitive to powdery mildew (oidium) and grey mold.

**GLOBAL EVALUATION:** Early variety, good resistance to transport and storage. A very interesting variety for all table grape producers.
